



## INFORMATION SECURITY POLICY STATEMENT

The Authority is committed in accordance with its purpose and values to maintaining and improving information security and minimizing exposure to information security risk within its environment to provide secure and quality service to our stakeholders.

The Authority shall therefore ensure that:

1. Information security risks will be maintained at an acceptable level.
2. The confidentiality of corporate information will be protected in accordance with an information classification standard. Sensitive information will be protected against unauthorized access and disclosure through the implementation of adequate controls.
3. Information shall be protected from manipulation and corruption by internal or external malicious actors while implementing adequate measures to ensure information processing facilities provide continuous services at the required levels of quality.
4. The requirements of interested parties including regulatory, contractual and legal obligations related to information security shall be identified and met.
5. Information Security will be considered when business continuity plans for critical activities are developed, maintained, tested or invoked.
6. Information security awareness will be made available to all employees and stakeholders as appropriate.
7. Top Management shall identify opportunities for continual improvement of the ISMS and support their implementation by availing necessary resources and guidance.
